RESPONSE TO GENERAL EMERGENCY

- Call **9-1-1**, if necessary.
- Account for all students.
- Evacuate students and stay with them.
- Notify superintendent and staff, immediately.
- Keep detailed notes of incident.

<u>FIRE</u>

In the event that a fire, smoke, or a gas odor has been detected:

- Pull the fire alarm.
- Account for all students and staff.
- Evacuate students to a safe distance outside of the building.
- Call **9-1-1**, if necessary.
- Notify superintendent and staff, immediately.
- Do not re-enter the building until declared safe by fire service personnel.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- Call 9-1-1, *immediately*.
 - When you call 9-1-1, have the following information available:
 - Age and gender of patient.
 - Location of patient.
 - Nature of emergency (i.e. breathing/ consciousness)
 - Any other patient information.
- Do not move patient unless absolutely necessary.
- Notify superintendent and staff, immediately.
- Keep detailed notes of incident.

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SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH

- Call **9-1-1**, *immediately*.
- Isolate injured student(s) / staff member(s), if possible.
- Account for all students and staff.
- Notify superintendent and staff, immediately.
- Keep detailed notes of incident.

VIOLENT SITUATION

- Notify police, if necessary.
- First, ensure the safety or students and staff members.
- Contain area of unrest; seal off as appropriate.
- Move students involved in disturbance to an isolated area.
- Notify superintendent and staff.
- Keep detailed notes of incident.
